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What is Research Enrichment Program?

- To develop amongst the Second Year B.Ed. Students an inclination towards Action research
- To equip the pre-service students with knowledge about the elements of the research work.
- To strengthen the understanding of steps of conducting Action Research Project.
- To make students aware of the research ethics and ethical principles to be followed at every stage.
- To empower the students to present the research work in the research forum.
