RENDEZVOUS-A TÊTE-À-TÊTE WITH OUR ALUMNUS

The alumni of any institution have an integral and inseparable connection to their alma mater. They are not just individuals who have graduated from an organization; rather they are people who have become personalities by virtue of their education at the institution and experience in the profession. The wealth of insights that the alumni possess is immense and this makes them torch bearers for the students of an institution.

Teacher preparation courses often seem to be divorced from ground realities of the profession. The gap between theory and the actual profession needs to be bridged, if future teachers are to be truly prepared to face the challenges of the profession. The alumni of the institute are today successful and contributing professionals, having faced the trials and tribulations of the profession with great courage and determination. Hence it was deemed worthwhile to tap this wealth of alumni resource and work collaboratively with them to make the teacher preparation program more meaningful and purposeful.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE ACTIVITY:

- It is an interview/dialogue with an alumnus that would be conducted once a month.
- It is theme-based and focused. (The theme is announced to the alumnus as well as the students in advance)
- The time duration for each interview would be 30 45 minutes.
- Students would be put in teams of 5 to 6. Each team would be allotted an alumnus.
- Each team would be in charge of the following:
 - Preparing a letter of invitation and a thank you letter addressed to the alumnus
 - Designing a flyer for the program with a photograph of the alumnus for that month.
 - Sending the flyer to the Manager, Principal, Staff and students
 - Procuring the bio-data of the alumnus and preparing a ppt on the same.
 - Preparing the interview questions, in consultation with the staff coordinators' and the concerned alumnus.
 - Designing the introductory slide
 - Introducing the alumnus
 - Concluding with a vote of thanks and college anthem
 - Preparing a brief report with images and necessary details

OBJECTIVES OF THE ACTIVITY

- To explore the possibilities of making the alumni, productive partners with the institute in a collective goal to enhance and enrich the student life.
- To promote sharing of insights by the alumni that would prepare student teachers to face the challenges of the profession.
- To encourage greater involvement of the alumni with the institute in teacher formation
- To inspire student teachers to make the best of the B.Ed. program offered by the institute and equip themselves with the requisite skill-set for the profession
- To develop organizational skills among the student teachers.

OUTCOMES OF THE ACTIVITY

At the end of the academic year, by virtue of the program, the student teachers would be able to;

- Brace themselves to face the professional and pedagogical challenges of the teaching profession.
- Organize events collaboratively.
- Realize their role as the future alumni of the institute.
- Comprehend the paradigm shift in the field of education.

DETAILS OF THE INITIATIVES TAKEN FOR BENEFIT TO STUDENT

The program was planned, organized and conducted by teams of student teachers with the help and guidance of the Staff Alumni coordinators. So far, the program has been conducted in the months of July, August, September and October and it is still going strong as follows;




- Making student led teams.
