Report on Orientation to Co-Curricular Activities (CCA)

Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs), also known as extracurricular activities, are an integral part of the educational experience. An induction to proposed Co-Curricular activity was conducted by Mrs Priti Ma'am and Dr Bijoy Sir on 20th January,2023. At the multipurpose FY B.Ed Classroom, St Xavier's Institute of Education. Mrs Priti opened the session by asking students why co-curricular activities are important for individuals? To which the students replied that it is important for all round development, helps refresh the mind, enhances skills and will also help students to one day conduct/host a Co-curricular activity. Satisfied by the responses Ma'am moved on to the objectives of this activity, they were displayed on the screen, while ma'am explained each one.

The purpose of this activity will be to display creative potentials, to take action on this year's theme which is Holistic education for valuing Diversity, help student teachers be more action oriented, understanding and develop planning and life skills. So this year's activity is a Musical play that

must have sub-themes of Inclusiveness, Cultural Diversity, Occupational Diversity and Holistic Education. Students are expected to present their play in 20 minutes, there must be a perfect blend of Dialogues (English) and songs (Hindi and English). To carry out this activity the class will be divided into 4 groups and those groups will be further divided into 8 groups. Students were added to these 8 groups on a lottery basis, our instructors had picked out roll numbers beforehand.

Each group will also be given a mentor teacher who will guide them through the action plan of the play. After the division of the groups, the students sent one representative from each group, to pick their themes which was again on lottery basis. Our instructors selected a lottery system so that there is no bias and each student gets a chance to display their talent. At the end of the presentation students were given a breakup of marks and on what basis they would be graded.
