Campus Placement Report 2022-23

The campus placement process of 2022-23 at St. Xavier's Institute of Education, Mumbai, was intended to provide students with the greatest number of opportunities to interact with prospective school employers and secure employment offers. The campus placement process was divided into three phases.

Pre-campus-placement programme

Student's Registration and Resume Submission: Students interested in participating in the campus placements were required to submit their resumes, highlighting their academic achievements, projects, internships, and extracurricular activities. The placement cell ensured the verification and standardisation of the resumes before sharing them with the school. For registration, students deposit a refund amount of Rs. 1000 to the college office. The faculty coordinators explained the terms and conditions of campus placement to the students.

School Registration: Several leading schools from the local, state, national, and international levels were invited to participate in the campus placement programme. Faculty coordinators coordinated with these schools to facilitate their registration and participation.

Pre-placement talks: Prior to the placement process, pre-campus placement programmes were conducted. Pre-campus placement programme activities provided students with insights into the participating companies and helped them make informed decisions. The primary objectives of the pre-campus programme were as follows:

Enhance Employability Skills: The programme aimed to develop and improve the employability skills of students, including communication skills, problem-solving abilities, critical thinking, teamwork, and leadership skills.

Provide school Insights: Students were exposed to the expectations and requirements of various schools through expert sessions.

Resume Building and Interview Preparation: The programme focused on assisting students in developing effective resumes that highlighted their strengths, achievements, and experiences. Mock interview sessions were conducted to familiarise students with the interview process and improve their interview performance.

Personal and Professional Development: The programme facilitated personal and professional development through sessions on personality development, NEP orientation, etc.

Pre-campus programme activities

The pre-campus placement programme consisted of a series of activities that spanned several weeks. The activities included:

Workshops and Training Sessions: Expert-led workshops and training sessions were organised to impart industry-specific knowledge, technical skills, and soft skills essential for a successful career. These sessions covered topics such as resume writing, group discussions, aptitude tests, coding skills, and effective communication.



Mock Tests and Assessments: To gauge the readiness of students for the placement process, mock tests and assessments were conducted to simulate the actual placement scenarios. These tests helped students identify their strengths and weaknesses and allowed them to work on areas that needed improvement. As a placement session, the placement cell conducted a mock interview session conducted by Sir Savio D'mello on January 4, 2023, where a very detailed look was given to us with regards to how the interview as a whole will look, what challenging questions we will have to face, and how to tackle those challenges. At the end of the session, all the questions and doubts were cleared, and many mistakes that weren't supposed to be repeated were highlighted by Sir Savio.

Interactive Sessions with Industry Professionals: Eminent professionals from various industries were invited to interact with students and share their experiences, insights, and expectations from prospective employees. These interactive sessions provided students with a practical understanding of industry trends and requirements.

Career Counselling and Guidance: Students were provided personalised career counselling and guidance sessions through mentoring to help them explore different career paths, set realistic career goals, and make informed decisions regarding their future. These sessions helped students align their interests, skills, and aspirations with potential job opportunities.

Publication of school details and registration of students

The placement cell shared the details of the registered schools and the vacancy list with the students. All the important details and circulars were shared with the students via the learning management system. Students were given time to choose the schools based on their interests and subject vacancies. The placement cell then shared the verified CVs of the candidates with various schools according to their interest, choice, and subject vacancies. A total of 40 schools and 42 students were registered for the campus placement programme during the academic year 2022-23.

Campus Placement Programme

The school selected the students based on the details of their CVs and prepared the shortlisted candidates list. The short-listed candidates were invited for face-to-face interviews during the campus placement programme. This year, campus placement programmes were held on 9th and 10, February 2023. The discussions and interviews with students aimed to assess the candidates' problem-solving skills, communication abilities, and fit within the organisational culture. Based on their performance in the interview and discussion process, students were selected by the schools for the demonstration of the lesson. The placement cell ensured transparency and fairness in the final offer distribution.

Post Campus Placement Programme

The post campus placement programme, organised by SXIE, aimed to provide comprehensive support and guidance to students who had successfully secured employment through the college's placement cell. The programme aimed to enhance the transition of students from academics to the professional world and ensure their successful integration into the workforce. The college facilitated mentorship programmes where students were paired with faculty members. Mentors provided guidance, advice, and support, helping students navigate their early career challenges and make informed decisions. The post campus programme ensured a smooth transition for students from college life to the professional world. 

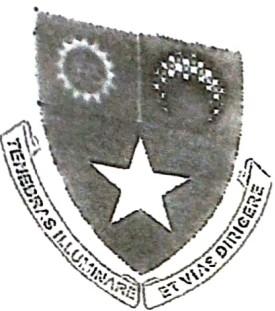
