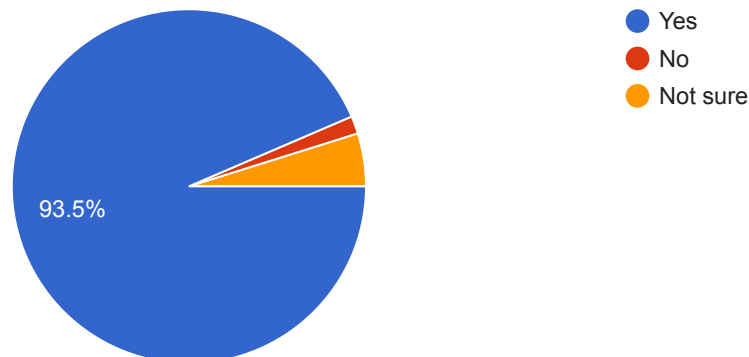

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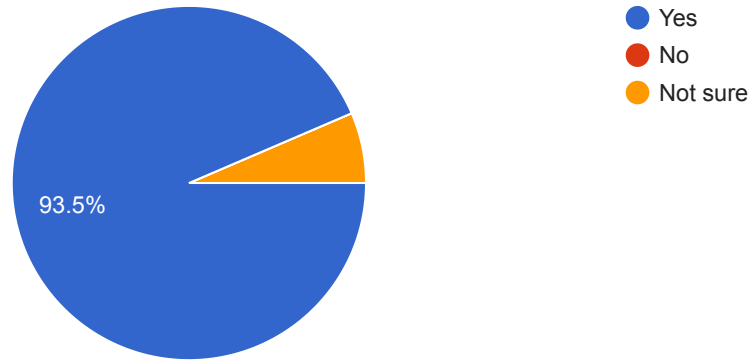

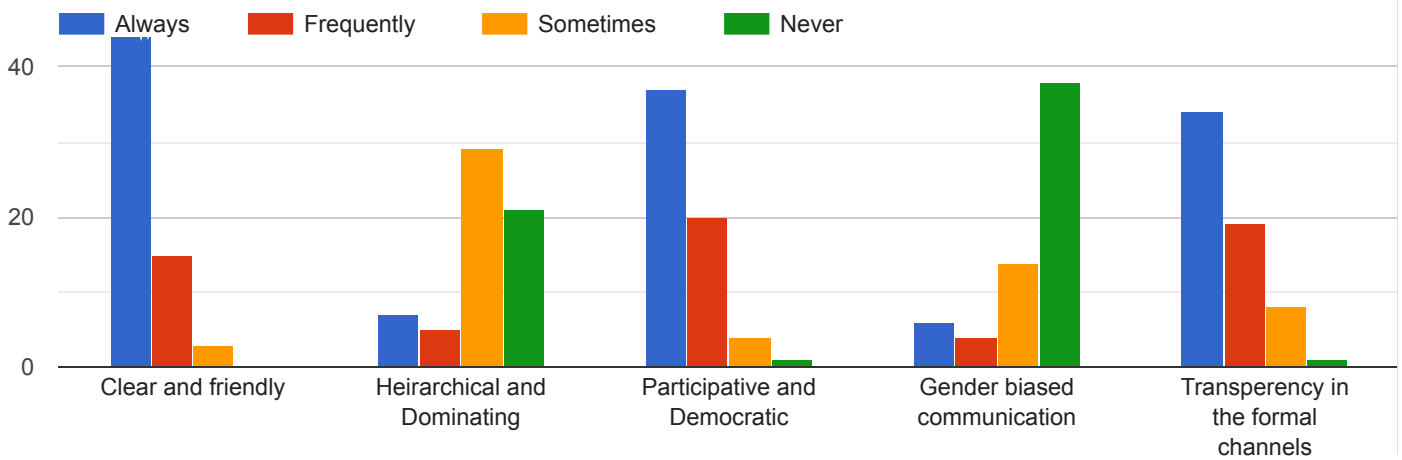

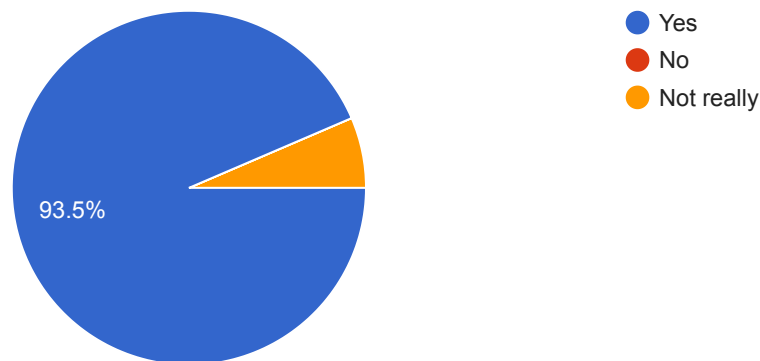

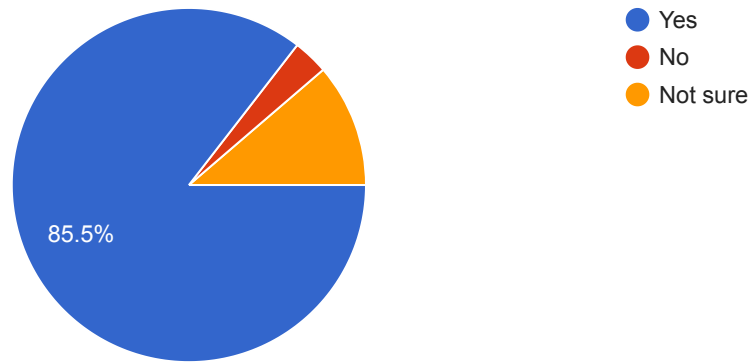

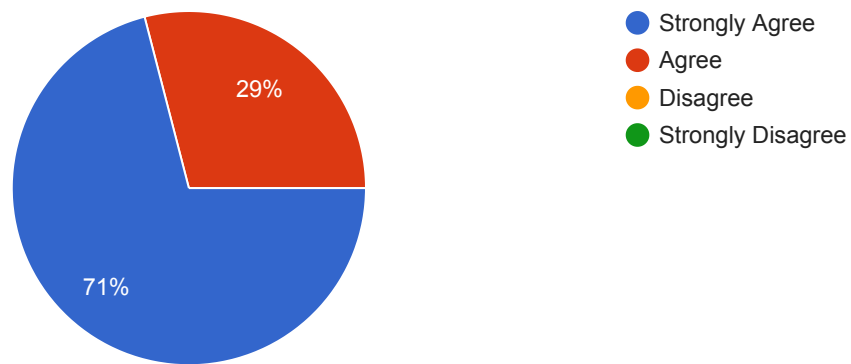

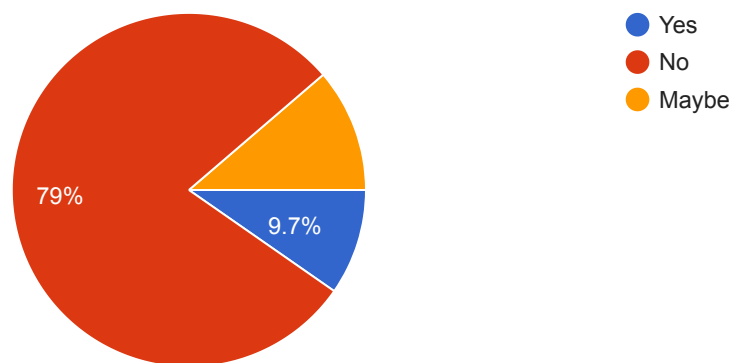

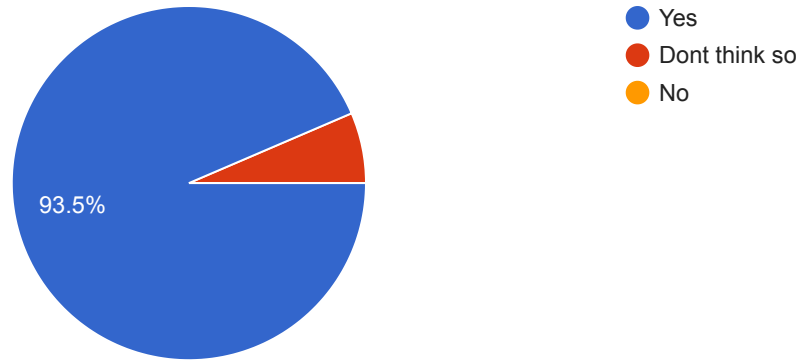

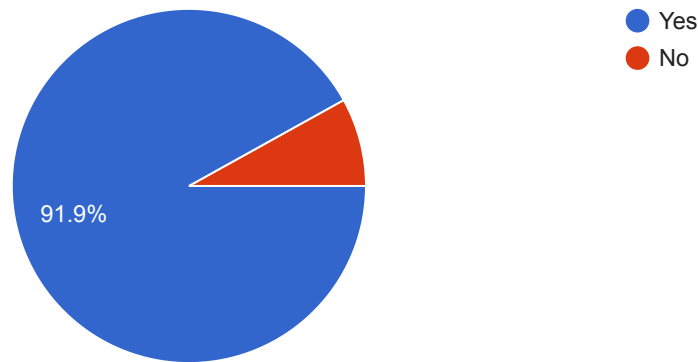

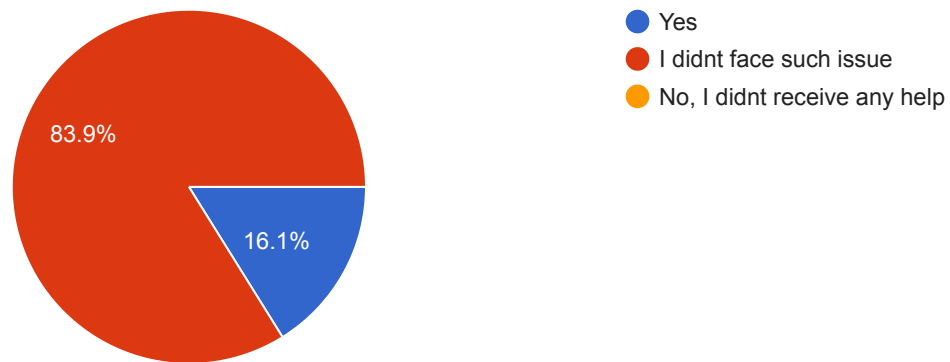

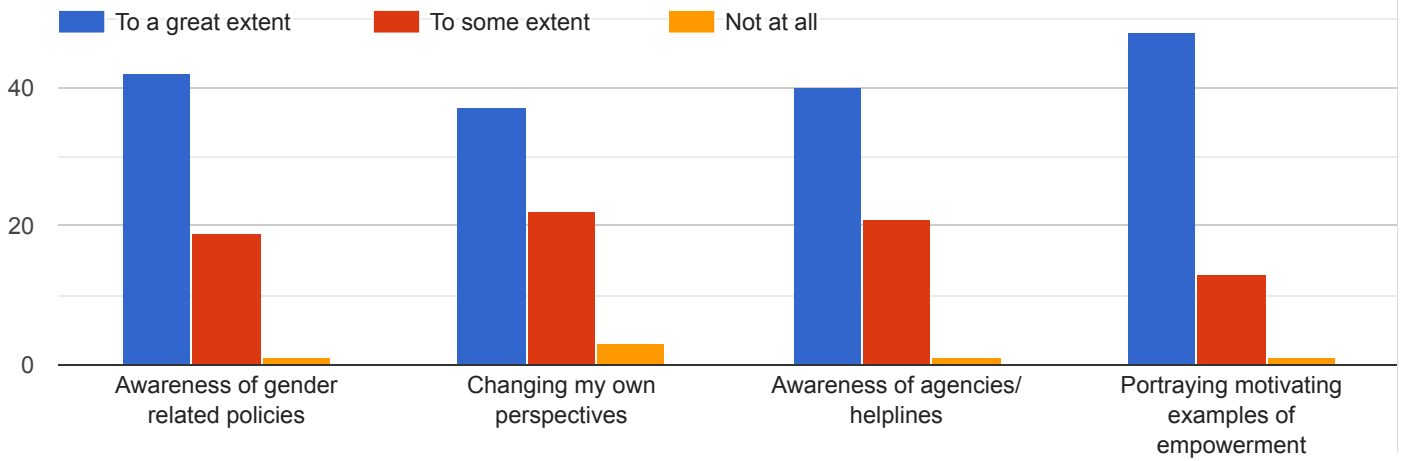

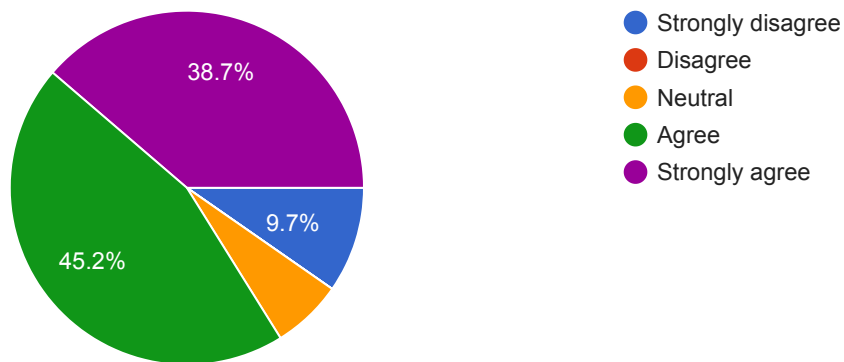

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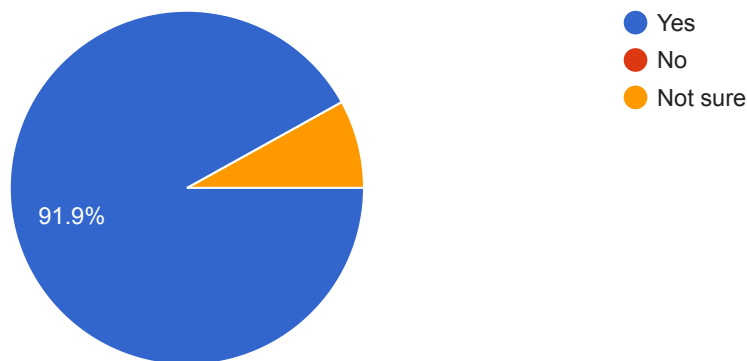

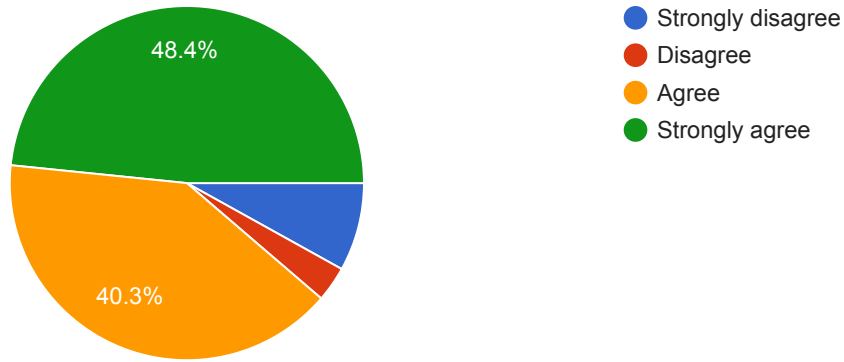

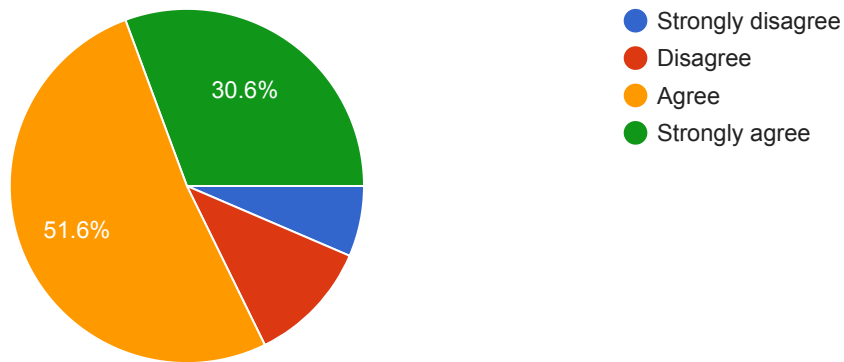

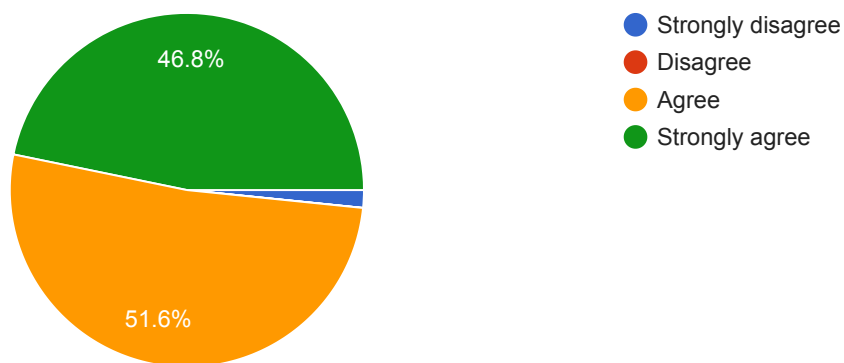

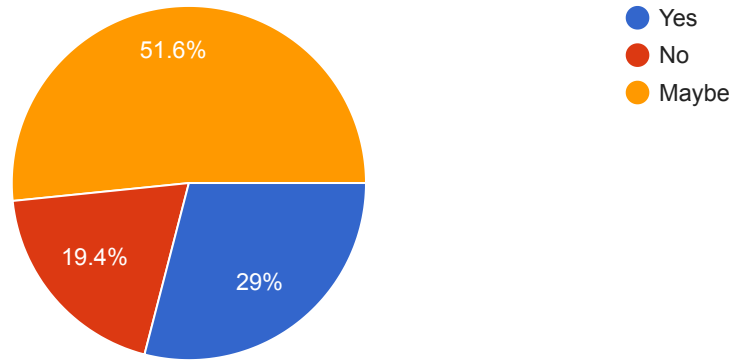

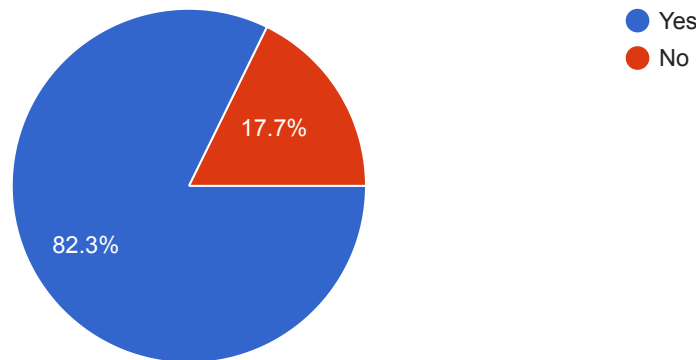

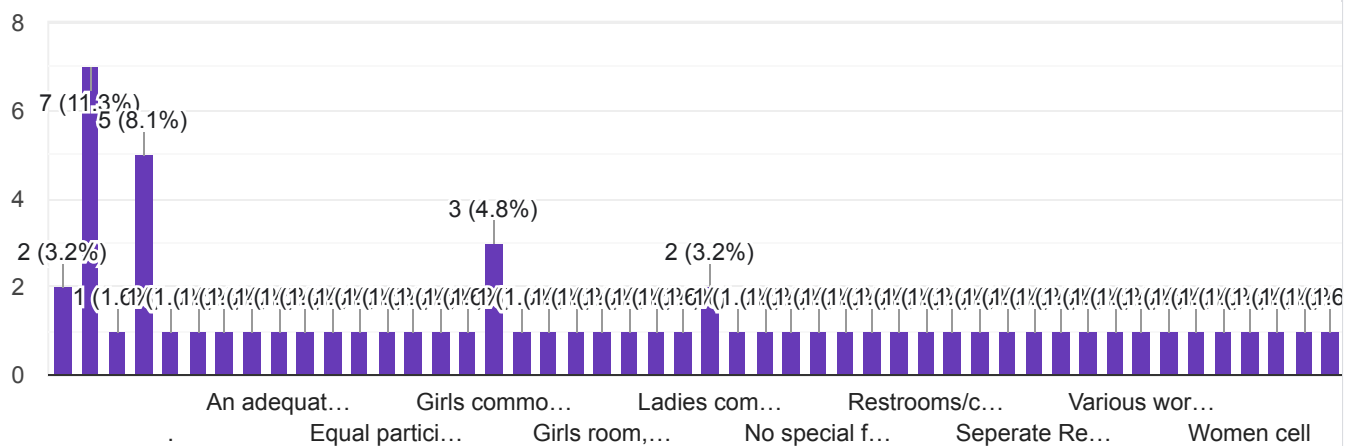

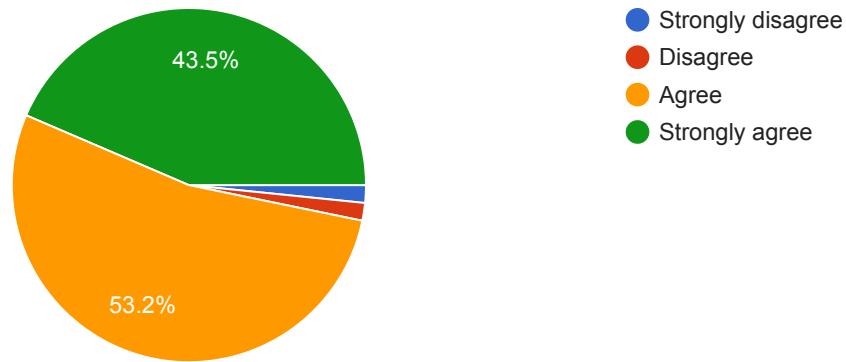

The hidden curriculum of the institution promotes gender equality



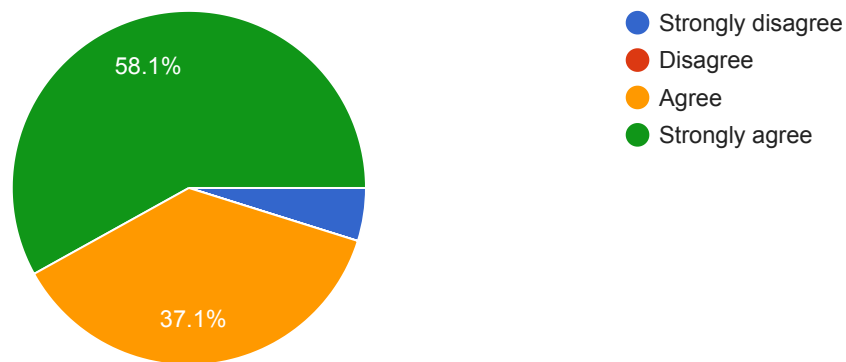

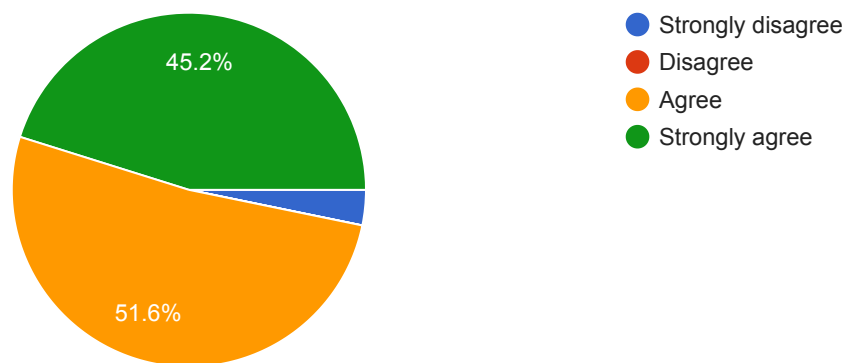

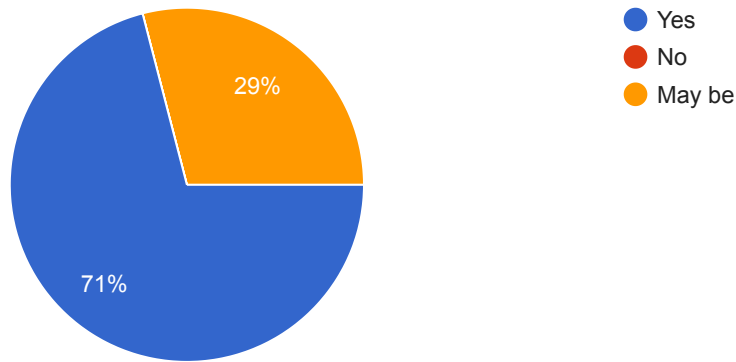
