Internship, which is part of the Project-based Course of the B.Ed.

The objectives of the Internship in Semester 1 at SXIE are as follows:

- To develop insights among student teachers regarding the dynamics of schooladministration.
- To develop among the student teachers and enable the application of the skills, theories, and concepts learned in the classroom.
- To facilitate the understanding of the multi-faceted role played by a teacher.
- To foster a sense of professionalism and right conduct among student teachers.
- To promote professional acumen through focused observation and reflection.

Internship at SXIE in B.Ed. two years follow the Syllabus of the University of Mumbai. The syllabus demands students to go for the internship for 11 weeks (55 days) to the schools in the city for their teaching practice and other school-related activities to learn and explore through experiential learning. Semester III is a rigorous internship activity for student-teachers and requires students to learn a variety of techniques to teach.

Internship Objectives:

The objective of the Internship for 2022-2023 (Semester III) was to -

- To facilitate understanding of the dynamic techniques that could be used in a secondary school.
- To foster a sense of professionalism and right conduct among student teachers.
- To develop various skills among student teachers.

Outcomes Expected from the Internship Programme:

- 1. Student-teachers become equipped and confident in taking lessons.
- 2. Students learn and display traditional and modern pedagogical skills while teaching.
- 3. Students should be able to do quality work in terms of content teaching and use of pedagogical devices (traditional and technological tools).

Semester III Lessons:

Semester III lessons were conducted in fourteen SSC schools and a supervisor was assigned to each group weekly to assess the lessons. There were 48 Students for the Batch of 2021-2023. Student-teachers were introduced and given training in new teaching techniques, including progressive learning techniques, experiential teaching strategies, and co-teaching techniques. The rubric sheet was used for this semester 3 internship performance assessment. Each lesson was of 10 marks. All the stages of the lesson (Set Induction, Presentation, Summarization, Evaluation, spread awareness of the core component, Assignment) were evaluated. In total students had to give 15 lessons of various types namely -

- General Pedagogy 2 lesson 05
- Pedagogy 1 Lessons 05
- Coteaching lessons -03 (Pedagogy 1)
- Theme-based lessons 02 (any pedagogy)

Any four of the above lessons could be experiential.

Students consulted their coaches and Lesson plans were mailed/ given by hand to the coaches in time, dates to start preparing and sending lessons were given. Some coaching slots were provided in the timetable for interaction and clearance of doubts, Supervision for all lessons was done. For the reflective journal, each lesson has to be used as a source of inspiration as well as all the school activities that the students participated in. - To develop various skills among student teachers to manage class
- To be able to use various evaluative techniques for the purpose of assessment

Outcomes Expected from the Internship Programme:

- 1. Student- teachers are able to identify the problems and issues that occur on day to day basis inside the
- 2. Student-teachers learn the practical approach of dealing with the inside and outside classroom issues.
- 3. Student-teachers become equipped and confident in taking lessons.
- 4. Students learn and display traditional and modern pedagogical skills while teaching.
- 5. Students should be able to do quality work in terms of content teaching and use of pedagogical devices (traditional and technological tools).

Semester IV Lessons:

For Semester IV lessons were conducted in ICSE schools and a supervisor was assigned to each group to assess the lessons. There were 48 Students for the Batch of 2021-2023. Student-teachers were introduced to and given training in new techniques of teaching which included progressive learning techniques, experiential teaching strategy, and coteaching techniques. The rubric sheet was used for this semester IV internship performance assessment. Each lesson was of 10 marks. All the stages of the lesson (Set Induction, Presentation, Summarization, Evaluation, spread awareness of the core component, Assignment) were evaluated. In total students had to give 10 lessons of various types. The following activities were conducted during the internship namely -

- Conduct Action Research
- During the Internship teaching not less than 5 lessons in the opted pedagogy of school subject II distributed over different standards from V to XII of recognized secondary and higher secondary Schools/ Colleges selected by the Principal as practicing Schools/Colleges.
- 5 Co-teaching lessons with peers
- Maintain a Reflective journal with reference to the internship program.
 Any four of the above lessons could be experiential.

Students consulted their coaches and Lesson plans were mailed/ given by hand to the coaches in time, dates to start preparing and sending lessons were given. Some coaching slots were provided in the timetable for interaction and clearance of doubts, Supervision for all lessons was done.
