- Programmes organised for career guidance

On 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2017, the institution had organised an enriching session with Professor Joseph Jesunathadas from California State University, San Bernardino. The main objective of the event was to educate us on future avenues post attaining our bachelor of

education degree. Professor Joseph Jesunathadas gave some insight into California State University – one of the largest public state Universities in the United States of America. He

then spoke about the program runs for educators specialising in the pedagogy of science as a school subject. This was followed by a brief question answer session.

- Campus Placement Pre interview Orientation program: In the run up to the main campus interview event on March 22<sup>nd</sup> recruiting schools visited S.X.I.E. to make pre campus placement presentations to students seeking jobs. In the presentations the schools oriented students to their culture, ethos and remuneration package, so that students could decide whether or not they wanted to interview with them on the final day. Beginning with Dubai Scholars Private School on 11<sup>th</sup> February a total of 9 schools made pre campus placement presentations to students. Each school was given a 15 minute slot in which they summarized what they stood for. The presentations helped the students to short-list which schools suited their own personal ethos.

- As a part of Campus Recruitment Cell, a session on Orientation to Higher Education was conducted on Thursday 22nd December, 2016 in St. Xavier's Institute of Education for the

second year B.Ed. students of the batch 2015-2017. The resource person was Dr. Sybil Thomas from the Department of Education, University of Mumbai. The session was organized for providing information about the different courses that a B.Ed. student can pursue for higher education after the completion of the B.Ed. course.

- Mock Interview: SXIE organised a mock interview workshop on 19<sup>th</sup> March 2017. Mr. Savio D'mello, Vice-Principal of St. Xavier's Boys Academy, conducted the workshop
- Workshop on International Boards: A workshop on international boards was done by Fazlani L'Academie Globale, in the month of February. The presentation was done by Ms. Arwa Baldiwala who is working as the Coordinator at the school. A brief introduction on international boards that schools have begun to adopt was given by her. It was an extremely helpful session for students which enlightened all about a school where the citizens of the future will be trained, developed, groomed and encouraged to think, explore and discover the new world for themselves.

No. of students benefitted: 50

- During the year 2016-17, one day orientation cum practice session was conducted for second year B.Ed students. Faculty had oriented and discussed questions and syllabus of various subjects. Teacher Eligibility Test known as TET is an eligibility examination for teachers. The test is mandatory for applying for teaching jobs in Government schools from Class 1 to Class 8. Due to its importance in the teaching profession, S.X.I.E. organized a Workshop on Teacher Eligibility Test on April 5th, 2017 for S.Y. B.Ed. students. The workshop was conducted by all faculty members at S.X.I.E., where each Professor addressed different areas. The professors oriented the students to the overall pattern of the exam. They also provided a method-wise orientation to different subject areas in the paper. Besides this, the professors provided valuable information on how to enrol for the exam and when it was conducted. The professors gave students examples of the types of questions that would be asked during TET exam.

- The session on POCSO Act was conducted by Fr. Savio Silvera, SDB on 16th February 2017. He dealt with the theme –“POCSO ACT” (Protection of Children from sexual Offence).The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO Act) 2012 was formulated in order to effectively address sexual abuse and sexual exploitation of children. The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 received the President's assent on 19th June 2012 and was notified in the Gazette of India on 20th June, 2012. Fr.

Savio concluded the session by saying that as an educator must be watchful, prudent, decent and dignified in one's own profession
