### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

In our endeavour to provide students a larger platform through talent-based competitions, St. Xavier's Institute of Education to bring once again presents this year – PRAYAS on 01<sup>st</sup> February 2020. PLEASE READ THE GUIDELINES SLOWLY AND THOROUGHLY. PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE DATES AND DEADLINES.

- 1) School/College ID's are compulsory and must be produced at the registration desk in order to be eligible for participation in any event.
- 2) Filling and submitting the entry form would mean that the team has fully read and understood the guidelines of the competition and are willing to comply by them. Any clarification would have to be before filling the entry.
- 3) Each team although competing against each other, should participate in the spirit of the community, without disparaging or discouraging each other on and off the stage.
- 4) Kindly make photocopies of the registration form for multiple events. Send the registration form via email (bijoyxsie@xsie.in / priti@xsie.in ) / hard copy can be sent to the college address.
- 5) **Last date for the receipt of registration - January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020**
- 6) The registration number of the team participating will be announced thrice and in case the team does not show up it is a 'NO SHOW'. It is the responsibility of the teams that all their participants are on time.
- 7) All correspondences and redressals should be done only through the Team Captain/Teacher in charge.
- 8) College Classrooms will be provided to the teams for resting and getting ready.
- 9) The Organisers reserve the right to take action against any team that may have falsified any information for this competition.
- 10) The decision of the judges will be final and binding. 1)
- 11) College authorities hold the right to cancel or change the event.

### I. FOR SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES

#### 1. EXPRESS AND IMPRESS (MIME)

*'Be as expressive as you can'*

**Theme** – Walking with the excluded

**No. of participants** –Team of 6 to 8 students per school/college. (One entry only per School / College)

**Time Duration** – 10 minutes

**Registration fees** : Rs. 250/- per team

#### RULES

- 1) This is a group event
- 2) Each team/group will get **10 minutes** from entry to exit for the mime performance which also includes the stage setup and stage clearance.
- 3) Integration of the theme has to be throughout the mime show.
- 4) The props should be brought and arranged by the participants themselves. No props will be provided by the college.
  - Emotions, music and action can be added as per your creativity.
  - All participants for the mime should be students from the same school/college.
  - Background music is instrumental only. Pen drive containing any sound tracks have to be submitted at the registration desk an hour prior to the event.
- 5) The act should not contain any dialogues / lip sync.
- 6) The handling of the props has to be done only by the participants.
- 7) No act shall contain any offensive, obscene, disrespectful actions / gestures. In case of non-compliance the entry will be disqualified.

- 8) Any kind of harmful tools / substances are prohibited on the stage.

#### 2. FOLK SWINGS (GROUP DANCE)

*'Collective wisdom, spontaneity & simplicity of folk dance'*

**Theme** – Any theme

**Number of participants** – Team of 6 to 8 students per school/college. (One entry only per School/ College)

**Time Duration** – 5 minutes. (For Both school and college)

**Registration fees** : Rs. 250/- per group

#### RULES

- 1) This is a group event
- 2) Each team should strictly adhere to the time limit
- 3) Any vulgarity through dress code, gestures and dance steps will lead to disqualification.
- 4) The music track should be given to the organizers an hour prior to the performance on the respective day.
- 5) Use of fire, snow spray, gualaal and other inflammable items or any item that can cause accident is strictly prohibited.
- 6) Participants are strictly prohibited from using any music or items that can hurt any national or religious sentiments.
- 7) Use of National Flag, National Anthem or national song is strictly prohibited

#### 3. PAINT THE PATH (POSTER MAKING)

*"Speak your heart through ART."*

**Theme** - Journeying with the youth for a better future

**Participants** - Maximum ONE entry only per School /College (One entry – two students.)

**Time Duration** - 1 hour

**Material provided** - Chart paper (A2)

**Registration fees** : Rs. 100/- per group

#### RULES

- 1) This is a group event (One Pair)
- 2) Drawing / Painting must be on A2 size paper that is provided by the college
- 3) Acceptable tools of drawing - Pencil, pen, sketch pen, markers, water colour, oil paint.
- 4) **\*(photographs, wires, other 3D objects are not acceptable). The artwork must be on a flat piece of paper and should be completed within the allotted time. Use of any plastic material for sticking on the poster is strictly prohibited.**
- 5) The drawing/painting must not include national flags, or political party slogans or symbols.
- 6) The drawing /painting must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any particular religious theme.
- 7) The theme should be the main focus of the poster.
- 8) Innovative captions are welcome. No direct statement of the theme to be written on the poster.
- 9) All posters must be made at the venue. Plagiarism should be avoided.
- 10) All posters submitted for competition shall become the property of SXIE.
- 11) The college / school code (allotted to participants at the venue) should be mentioned on the chart.
- 12) Do not reveal your personal/school/ college identity by any means, failing which the team will be disqualified.

## II. FOR SCHOOLS ONLY

### 4. WASTE MATTERS! (BEST OUT OF WASTE)

*“Don't throw away, RECYCLE it for another day.”*

**Theme** - Care for Our Common Home (Earth)

**No. of participants** – Maximum ONE entry only per School  
(One entry – two students.)

**Time Duration** – 1 hour.

**Registration fees** : Rs. 100/- per group

#### RULES

- 1) This is a group event (One Pair)
- 2) One useful/decorative article out of waste materials in a pair.
- 3) Students have to bring the basic waste material from home.  
**Please bring your own material resources.**
- 4) Eco-friendly reusable material can be used. (Note – Use of Plastic, thermocol and other materials which are harmful for environment is prohibited.)
- 5) Students are not allowed to bring any partially or fully made item; all preparations MUST be completed at the venue and within the allotted time.
- 6) Students have to present the prepared item before the judges.

### 5. RAP IT UP (RAP)

*“Wrap yourself to the beats of your Revolutionary Artistic Persona”*

**Theme** – Journeying with the youth.

**No. of participants** – Maximum ONE entry only per School  
(One entry – two students.)

**Time Duration** – 05 minutes

**Registration fees** : Rs. 100/- per group

#### RULES

- 1) This is a group event
- 2) RAP can be in either English or/and Hindi.
- 3) The RAP should be appropriate to the given theme.
- 4) The RAP should not be derogatory.
- 5) The RAP should not exceed 3 minutes.
- 6) Vulgarity is strictly prohibited. In the event of non-compliance the entry will be disqualified.

## III. FOR COLLEGES ONLY

### 6. MIND YOUR LANGUAGE (JAM - JUST A MINUTE)

*“Can you make it through 60 seconds of non-stop talking without hesitation, repetition or deviation?”*

**Theme:** Journeying with the Youth

**No. of participants** – Max TWO participants per institute.

**Topic** – will be given on the spot.

**Time Duration** – 60 seconds per participant

**Registration fees** : Rs. 50/- per participant

#### RULES

- 1) This is an individual event
- 2) Each participant will be given a topic on the spot
- 3) Each participant will be given 5 minutes to prepare.
- 4) The sub-themes will differ in each round.
- 5) The topics will be related to the subthemes for the round.
- 6) The topic will be allotted on the basis of lottery system.
- 7) The competitor will be given a placard in order to voice their objections.
- 8) The judges and organisers will make note of objections raised, marks gained or lost by the participant.
- 9) The competitors will gain 1 point for raising a valid objection and get 1 negative marking for raising a faulty objection
- 10) The objections can be raised with reference to;  
Slurs, Repetition, Slangs, Paraphrasing and Tempo consistency

### 7. PITCH PLEASE (GROUP SINGING)

*“Make it sound like pitch perfect.”*

**Theme** – Care for Our Common Home (Earth)

**No. of participants** – Team of 6 to 8 students per college.  
(One entry only per institute)

**Time Duration** – 05 minutes

**Registration fees** : Rs. 250/- per group

#### RULES

- 1) This is a group event
- 2) The group should consist of MAXIMUM 8 members and MINIMUM 6 [including maximum 2 accompanist, if any]
- 3) The songs can be in Hindi / English.
- 4) The songs cannot exceed 05 minutes per team. The song can either be a mashup or a full length song.
- 5) We recommend that the team wears the same costumes for uniformity. However there are no additional points for costumes.
- 6) Organisers will provide one connection for any sound equipment.
- 7) Do not include National anthem/songs of any country.

### 8. PICTURE IS WORTH THOUSAND WORDS (PHOTOGRAPHY)

*“Explore the city through your phone lens.”*

**Theme** – Walking with the excluded.

**No. of participants** – Max TWO participants per institute.

**Time Duration**- 3 hours.

**Registration fees** : Rs. 50/- per participant

#### RULES

- 1) This is an individual event
- 2) It is a photography competition with a suitable caption.
- 3) Participants can click up to 5 photographs per entry to convey the given theme.
- 4) Time stamp application should be used.
- 5) The participant will have to register at 9.00 am. Time will be given between 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. for submission of photograph.
- 6) Rename the image file with your Participant number and re-confirm whether the image file is received at the submission desk on time. The Subject Line will be same as the file name.
- 7) The image file is to be submitted along with the caption (Mail Id/USB will be provided at the time of registration.)
- 8) No participants are allowed on or near the stage.
- 9) No editing of the photo will be allowed.
