Please note the following guidelines regarding the final submission of your paper:

Abstract: Each paper should contain an abstract, a maximum of 250 words that appears at the beginning of the document.

Length: A maximum of 2500 words, including all text, figures, tables and references.

Language: All presentations must be in English. Font: Use the Times-Roman font, font size 12 throughout the paper, including figure captions and heading in font size 14.

Margins: Margin of "1" should be left from Top, Left, Right, & Bottom, **Line Spacing:** 1.5"

Title: The title must appear in boldface letters and should be in all capitals. The next line should mention the subtheme under which the paper is sent.

Author Name: The author's name(s) and affiliation(s) appear below the title.

Body: Major headings appear in boldface letters, at the start of the left margin of the column. Use single spacing throughout the document.

File Format: You use the Word file, .doc format. Paper size must be A4 paper layout.
