SevaSadan's students Feedback of the session conducted by our staff at SevaSadan's college of Education

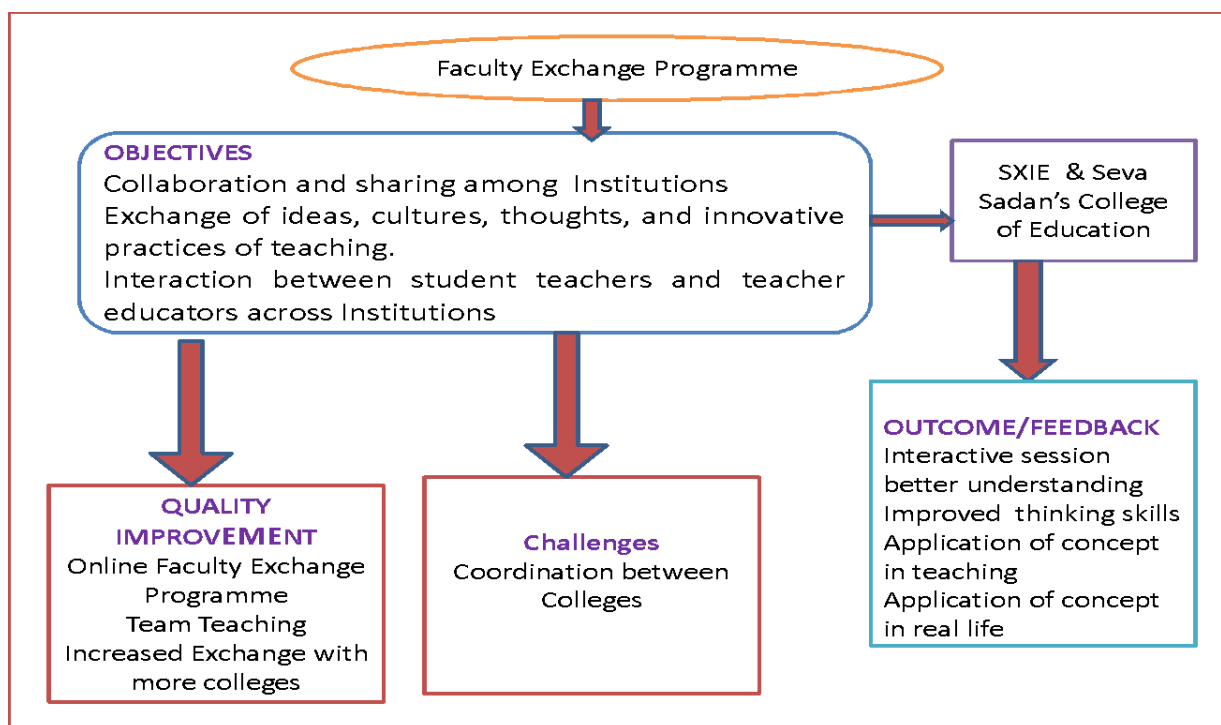
