SESSION 1

NEP INPUT FOR B.ED. STUDENTS

Number of students attended : 45 students (Day 1) 48 students (Day 2)

October 22 and 23 from 2p.m. -3p.m.

This session was conducted by Principal and staff (GS,VS, EP,PS and NK)

The thrust was on the School Education and Higher Education. Dr. Sosamma Samuel presented the overall development of NEP 2020 to the students, which was followed by the presentation of the School structure by Dr. Geeta Shetty and Dr. Vini Sebastian. Dr.Elвина

Periera, Ms. Priti Sivaramakrishnan and Ms. Nishi Kumar presented on Higher Education. The students were given the input and were presented a padlet to write their perceptions on NEP 2020.

The assignment of CC4 – Assessment for Learning, was also based on NEP 2020, where the students were assigned certain parts of the NEP 2020 and asked to analyse and write the implications for Education and their career. They were asked to present their thoughts meaningfully and present it for the assignment.

Feedback : Both the sessions were extremely beneficial, these sessions could have been conducted much earlier in the semester. The inputs were given quite fast due to paucity of time so may be it could be slower for better understanding.

SCHOOL EDUCATION: PERSPECTIVES AND CHALLENGES

Date : 4th December , 2020

Focused Deliberation on NEP 2020- School Education – Perspectives and Challenges

A meeting of school principals was held on zoom. The following members attended the meeting.

Dr. Sosamma Samuel, Principal, welcomed all. Dr. Geeta Shetty then presented the objectives of the activity.

The main focus areas which were presented were as follows:

- New Pedagogical and Curricular structure
- Teacher Quality and transforming Institutional culture
- Governance and Accreditation

The following points emerged in the deliberation:

- Training of Aanganwadi workers through online mode
- Boosting School Infrastructural requirements for implementation of NEP
- Service conditions and professional development of preschool teachers (pay scales , gratuity)
- Admission to preschool level not clear
- Teaching through Mother tongue or Regional language in a city like Mumbai may be more applicable to rural areas
- Technological gadgets provided but internet would be a problem
- ECCE is under RTE is a big concern – Admission of students then would be difficult as it has to be under RTE
- Centralization of authority
- Learner diversity is mentioned but Equity policy is not clear
- Children's likes and abilities need to be differentiated
- Human and financial resources in schools need to be taken care of
- Sharing of resources in a school complex, and with community would be difficult as there could be safety issues
- Schools must be open to trainee teachers at ECCE and B.Ed. levels and take interest in their training
- Are private schools under the ambit of NEP 2020 and how will aided and unaided schools collaborate is not clear in admission and sharing of resources
- Choice of subjects – student's choice must be considered instead of parents' interest
- Schools must have autonomy for community engagement, secular activities must be encouraged
- Talent nurturing must be encouraged in schools
- Exam orientation must reduce
- More research must be encouraged in schools
- Reflective practices must be encouraged
- Pupil teacher ratio must be balanced for effective interaction and classroom management
- Integration of curricular and extra curricular activities more clarity on this is required
- Reduction of syllabus is mentioned to accommodate innovative types of learning and teaching , more clarity is needed in this area.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Elvina Pereira.

SESSION 3

National Webinar on ‘TRANSFORMING SCHOOL EDUCATION -NEP 2020 (Perspectives and Challenges)

December 12, 2020

Concept Note:

Education is the key to all development that leads to India’s ascent to a global stage in terms of economic growth, social justice and equality, scientific advancement, national integration and cultural preservation. The main thrust of the National Policy of Education 2020 is high-quality education for developing and maximising the country’s rich human resource which lead to shaping India’s future. The world is undergoing rapid changes in knowledge and education systems need to keep pace with this change. The NEP 2020 presents a world that is dynamic therefore an education system that is enriched and flexible catering to different needs of the child as well as the society. The focus on school education has been with the objective to develop individuals that are productive and creative. The curriculum has been visualised to promote high level of creativity, thus the pedagogy envisioned is more experiential, holistic, integrated, inquiry-driven, discovery-oriented, learner-centered, discussion -based , flexible and enjoyable. The current level of learning outcomes must be bridged to attain high levels of learner attainment. The policy throws light on different aspects of how this can be achieved. Another aspect of the policy is to entrust the inculcation of India’s traditions and culture on to the education system as a major responsibility. The teachers here are the centre of the implementation of the policy and understanding and implementation of the policy thus becomes paramount.

Approx 403 people had registered, 120 people consisting of teachers and administrators attended the webinar, only 112 teachers filled the feedback . Participation from Maharashtra, Jamshedpur, Patna, Telangana and Kerala.

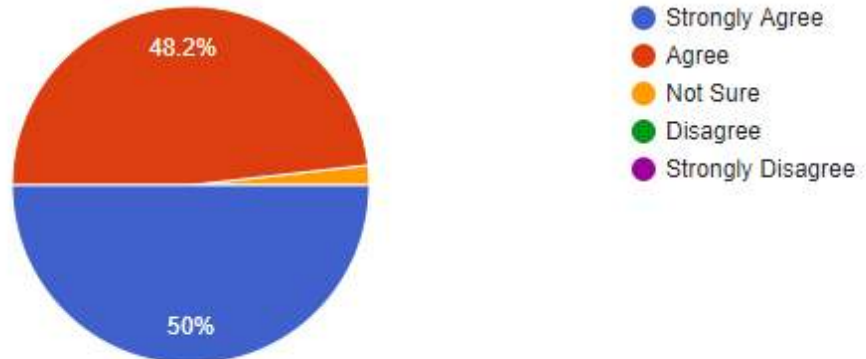

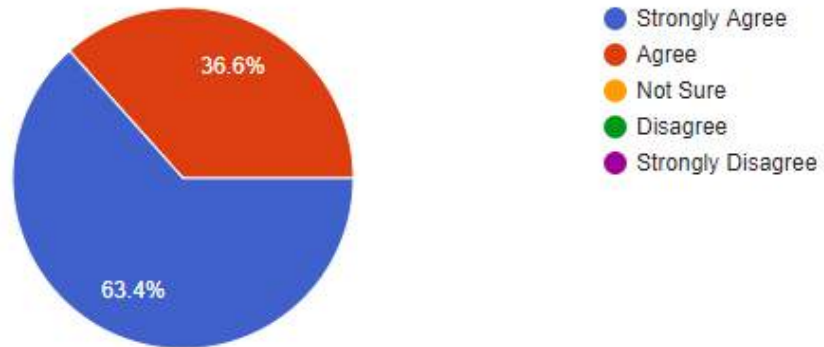

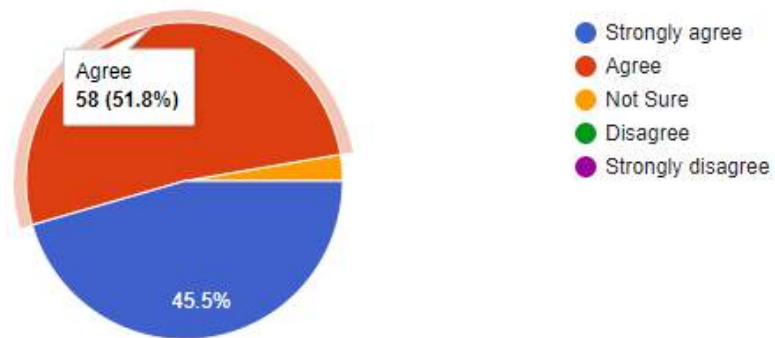

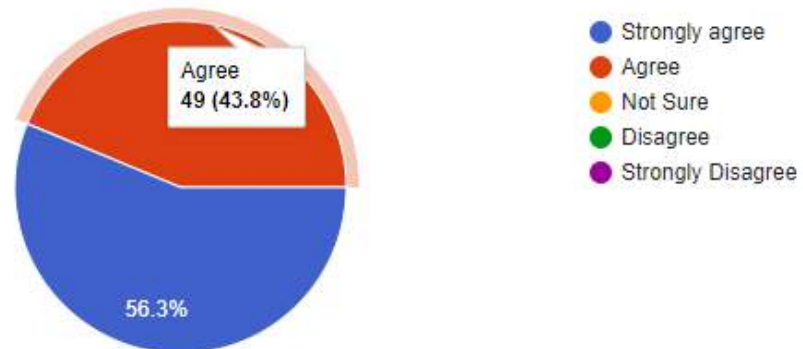

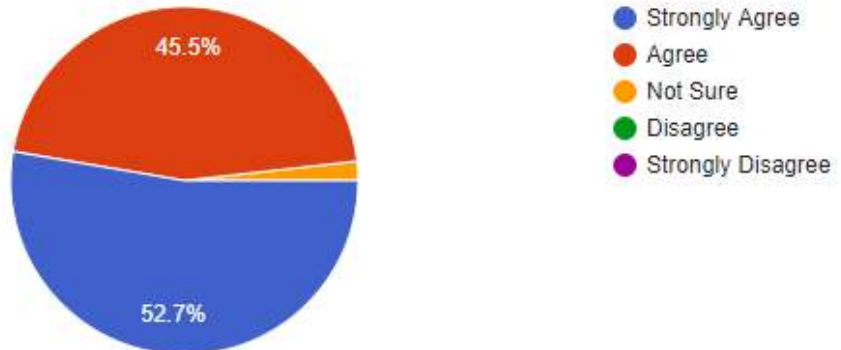

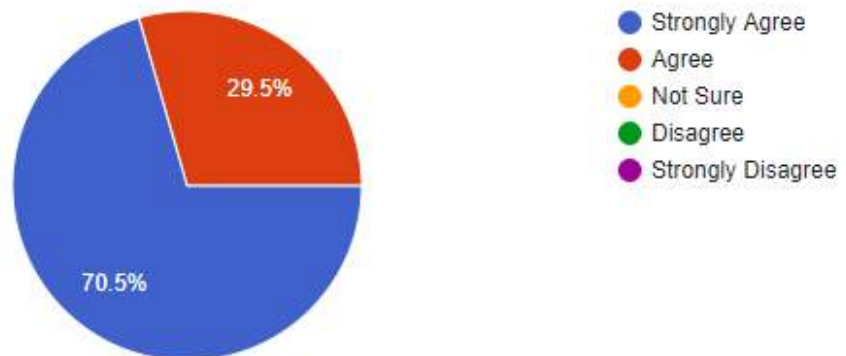

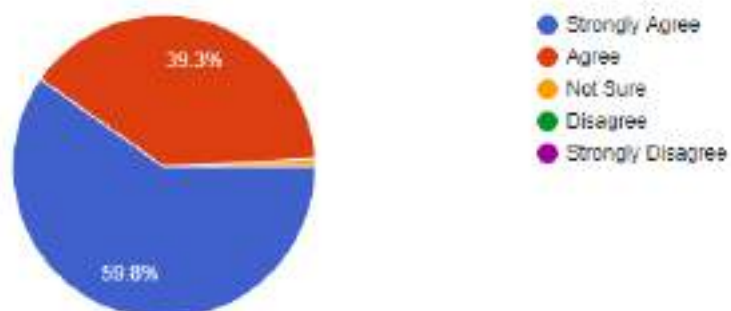

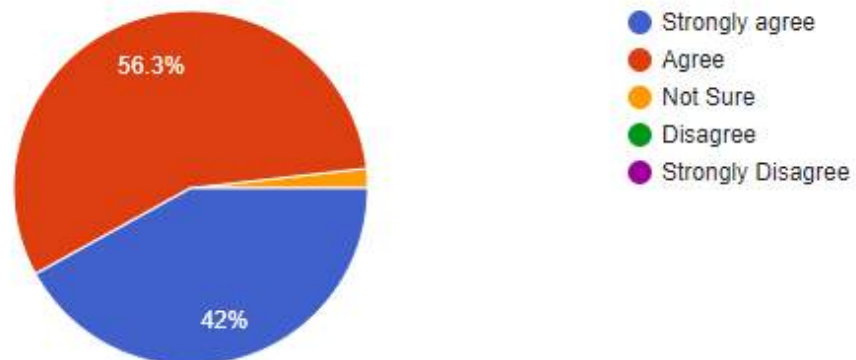

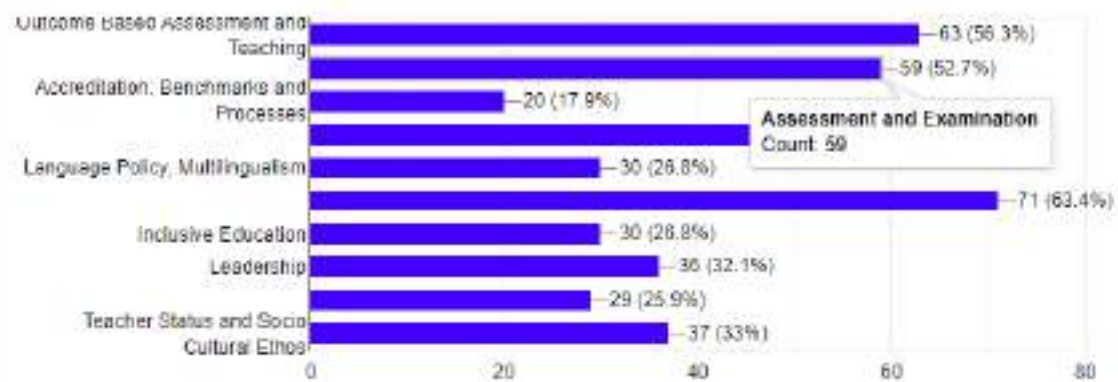

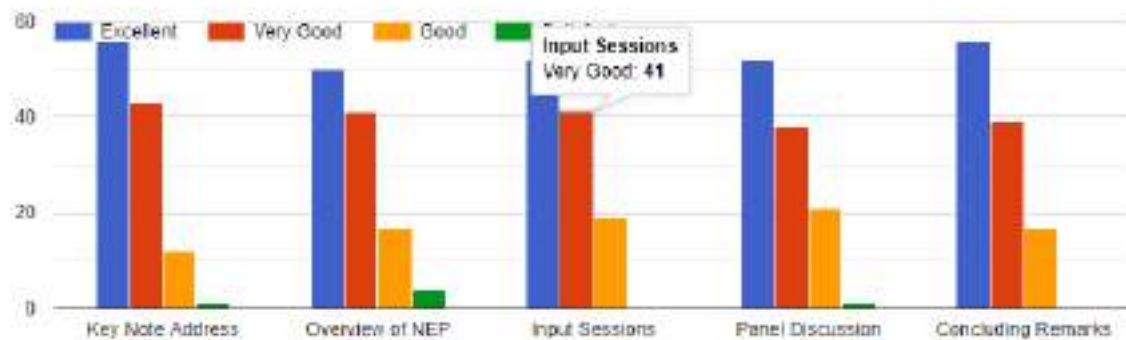

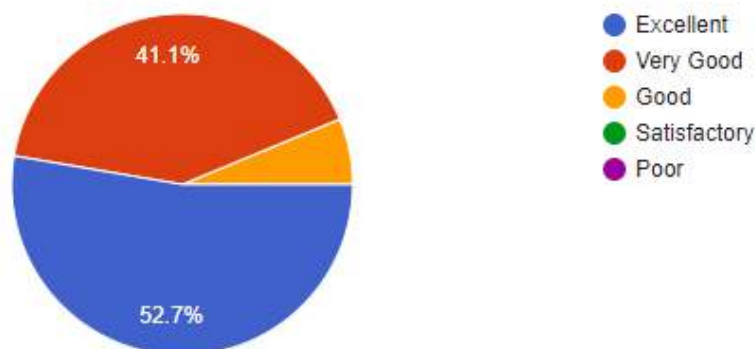
