WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL AND X LED – LEADERS FOR OTHERS

The Xavier's Leadership Efficacy Development Program (XLED) encourages the students to take the lead to disseminate their talents and skills to those interested. One aspect of leaders took on vocational skills to be taught to the students interested. The Women Development Cell faculty in charge invited women from the NGO , YWCA to learn these vocational skills so that they can use it to create more such products for self-employment. This was arranged on **16th April , 2019** .Ms. Sharon Ms. Sarrah and Ms. Loretta received certificate for training the women from the NGO. Thus, this was a part of creating entrepreneurs amongst the women from NGO and student leaders to realise that they can be the instrument to help others become self-reliant. The women trainers from NGO were happy that as they could learn simple skills like crochet making, jewelry making from eager and effective student teachers. The role of a leader was to help others to be empowered. Although this was a small step , it was a means to show the student teachers whatever talent they had could be of use to someone, and they should help others.

The women from YWCA were also invited to attend the **Orientation to Entrepreneurship Development Cell** which was another means to promote skill development and employment. The women interacted with the students first about how the NGO helps them to be self-employed and reliant and later interacted with the resource person invited to speak on Entrepreneurship and Skill Development. In the feedback the women said that these workshops and interactions have been very useful to them and they can utilize and disseminate the knowledge and skills they received from the student teachers and the resource person.

As per the recommendations of the University of Mumbai and Students' Welfare Department the Institute invited the Director of Students' Welfare Dept., Dr. Sunil Patil for orientation to importance and functioning of the Entrepreneurship Cell. Mr. Deshmukh, ex-officio of the Dept., made the presentation for all the students of the College as Dr. Patil was called for an urgent meeting at the Governor's office. He stressed that this Cell intends to create educated entrepreneurs who rather than being under-employed or unemployed can create employment for others through their start-ups. Moreover, professional college like SXIE can conduct skill development courses, workshops for the local people around them to empower them financially. Sir also stressed on leadership qualities and risk-taking characteristics to keep teaching profession updated and enterprising. The IQAC committee was urged to study the different funding at State and National level for encouraging skill development amongst the students. The YWCA women officials were also invited to participate in the orientation talk and expressed their appreciation towards collaboration with SXIE Women Development Cell and would want to be a part of Entrepreneurship Development Cell too.

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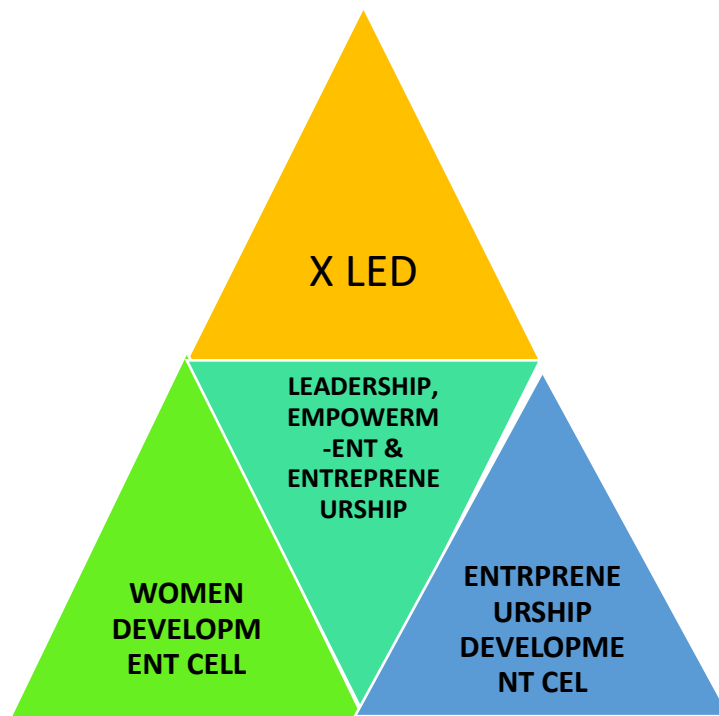
