There was an overwhelming response to register for the competition and it was a great success as 80% of the crowd was able to also submit their articles in the time given (from 29th May to 15th June 2020)

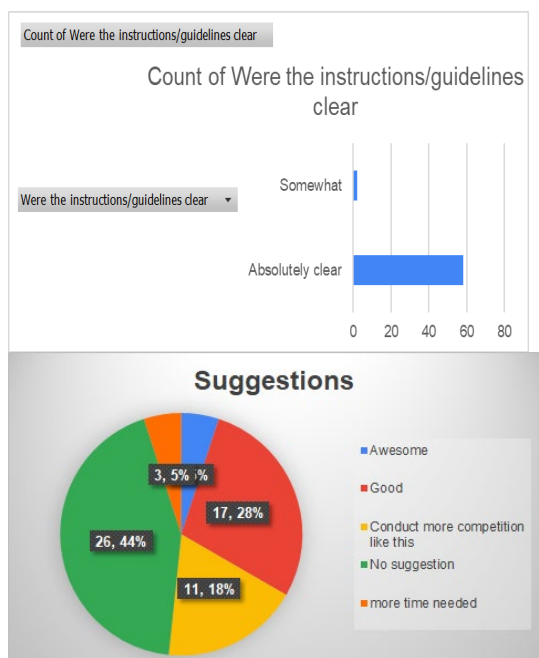
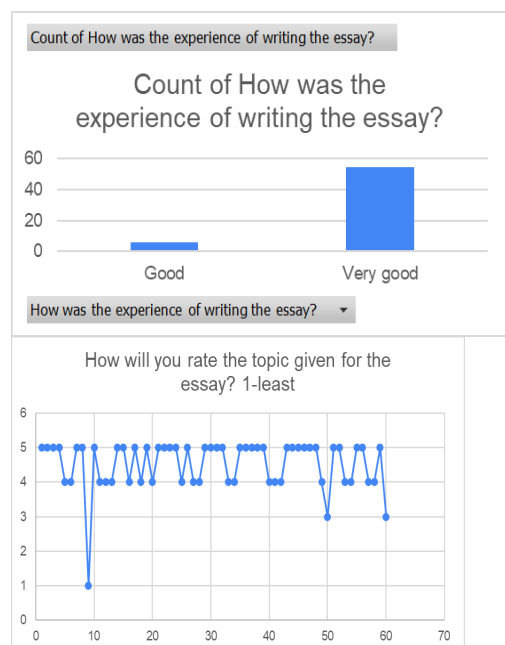


Essays were evaluated by external judges and following were the results:

- E-13 = 84% - A – Sophiya Lemos SXIE
